

Kurt Arne Eriksson 1938–2021

Kurt Arne Eriksson of San Jose, passed away Tuesday January 12th, 2021 at the age of 82. Born in Hunnestad, Sweden, Kurt was raised by his parents, Erik and Elvira Andersson.

After graduating from Chalmers University in Gothenberg, getting married and having 2 fabulous daughters, Lena and Rika, he and his family left his native Sweden for the Netherlands and then on to the US where he began his 26 year career at Comsat. Kurt relished in his role as "Pop" and Grandfather to Will, Anya, Pete, Jack, James and David. He was looking forward to getting to know his 2 great-granddaughters, Emma & Madison. He was predeceased by his parents and his granddaughter Anya Linnea Salus.

Kurt loved traveling the world, but his favorite place to visit was Sweden. There he spent time with his brothers Owe and Stellan and their families, and his aunts, uncles, cousins and his childhood friends with whom he always kept close contact with.

Kurt had so much joy in what he did, it took him many years before he finally retired at the age of 78. Kurt was respected and admired in his work. Colleagues describe him as a gentleman and intellectual, kind and meticulous. He was a gentle soul who loved nothing more than sharing his wisdom and being a mentor to many.
