Jerome "Jerry" Breslow, 92, passed away peacefully on Friday, September 4, 2026, in Silver Spring, Maryland.

Jerry lived a rich, dynamic life anchored by his love for music, dedication to law and business, and a deep commitment to his community. A graduate of Columbia College and Harvard Law School, Jerry combined sharp intellectual rigor and a quick, warm humor with a lifelong passion for the arts.

Jerry spent over three decades at COMSAT, primarily as Corporate Secretary. Parallel to his legal career, Jerry was an accomplished musician who poured his creative talents into Hexagon for over 40 years—writing, performing, and serving as President and board member. A member of Congregation Har Shalom for over 50 years, Jerry served as President of the synagogue and the Men's Club, and was the founder and decades-long director of the choir. His devotion to community was equally evident in his service as an Honorary Trustee of Strathmore, as well as a board member for the Montgomery County Youth Orchestra and the Suburban Hospital Foundation.
